Canada Day -

Here is a tentative schedule of events:

Fire works -will be held on Wednesday June 30th @ approximately 10pm at the Marine Rail Park. Starting at 6 we will have live entertainment, our annual mussel and corn boil. Also a line dancing demonstration by Trish Taylor. The Cavendish Farms Fry Wagon will be set up and we will also be providing cake, juice and games for the kids.

Learn to Bike & Bike Rodeo (July 1st) - As part of the province wide go!pei initiative Cycling PEI will be on hand to provide a learn to bike demonstration at 9am in the arena parking lot. This is for **ALL AGES**. Following this demonstration the Borden-Carleton Police Dept. will be holding a Bike Rodeo at 10:00am. During this time the Police Personnel will be teaching the children of the community about the importance of bike safety. Please insure your children have proper safety equipment for bicycling and all participants **MUST** have a helmet. There will be a number of prizes including a new bike!

Flag Raising & Cake Cutting -- will be held Thursday, July 1st at G.C. Bell Civic Building (Police/Fire Dept.) starting at 12 Noon. At this time the Borden-Carleton Community Awards will be presented. These awards include: Citizen of the Year, Youth of the Year, and Volunteer of the Year as well as our community beautification awards for Most Improved Property and Best Overall Property.

Parade -The parade will start at 1:00 on Route 10 and end at the arena. All entries are asked to be there by 12:30 to get lined up. We are still accepting entries into the parade so anyone interested in entering the parade can call 437-2410.

The Fire Department will once again be sponsoring a blow up playhouse house and will also be putting on a demonstration. We are bringing back the mock jail to the arena so feel free to throw a friend or family member behind bars!!

We also have a great selection of carnival games. Tickets for these games will be only 25 cents each. There will also be a new and improved variety show, a survivor game at the ball field and the annual councilors BBQ at 4pm.

The Borden-Carleton Seniors will be selling ice cream as well.

The Borden Legion is providing free pool from 11am-6pm.

A Rink Dance will be held at the Gateway Arena on Saturday July 3rd from 10:00pm-2:00am and for the first time will feature 2 live bands. "***Island Jam***" and "***Platinum Drive***". This will be a licensed event for those 19 & over. Cost to attend is \$7 in advance and \$10 at the door. Tickets are available at the community office and the arena. The Legion will be hosting a BBQ throughout the evening.

2010 Summer Recreation Program Brittney Sheffield and Mallory Morrell have been hired to run the Summer Recreation Program.

Day Camp - Starting July 5th until August 27th for ages 6-12 located at the Gateway Arena. Cost is \$60.00 per child or \$85.00 per family for the entire summer. Children will experience fun outdoor and indoor activities while staying active. Campers will also take a field trip possibly to the Mill River Fun Park or Crystal Beach Campground. Camp runs from 1pm-5pm Monday through Friday. Summer workers are done for the day by 5:10pm and are not required to stay until all kids are picked up so please have them picked up by 5pm.
