Traffic Safety Initiative: Carleton Street Speed Bumps with Provincial Approval

In a collaborative effort to enhance road safety, the Town of Borden-Carleton has received approval from the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure to install speed bumps on Carleton Street. The town has now purchased these speed bumps, and new warning signage will be installed

alongside them to alert drivers and ensure a safer environment

PERMITS – ARE REQUIRED

Whenever a structure is built or placed on a property a development permit is required.

Permits are required for the following:

- ✓ Fences (All fences must be on the owner's property)
- ✓ Swimming Pools (fencing also required)
- ✓ Food Trucks /Temporary Vendors
- √ Storage Buildings/Garages
- ✓ Temporary Recreation Trailers
- ✓ Signage

How to Apply: Permit applications are available at the Town office or can be requested by emailing admin@bordencarleton.ca.

Please Note: A minimum two-week processing time should be anticipated for all permit applications.















